- HEAVY YIELDER**
1. Beauregard

Developed at Louisiana Agri Exp. Station. Has a copper skin, moderately orange flesh, and is consistent in shape. Tolerant to Soil Pox. Outyields all other Sweet Potatoes. Does not crack open. Will yield 400-500 bushels per acre. Good cash crop. Resistant to white grubs and soil rot. Susceptible to root knot nematode. **80-90 days. (Vine type)**

2. Georgia Jets Red Yams

Remarkable hardiness. Great for our northern neighbors. Has rose petal skin that truly stands out in the field. Light orange meat. Excellent baker. Great for truckers and peddlers. Matures about 80-90 days with normal rainfall. **(Vine type)**

3. Centennial

Bred at Louisiana Exp. Station at Baton Rouge 1962. Orange, smooth skin, yields heavy in normal year. Great for truckers and peddlers. Good grade of potatoes. Also has tolerance to fusarium wilt and internal cork. Stores well. **About 90 days. (Vine type)**

4. Carolina Ruby

Developed by Dr. Wanda Collins at N.C.S.U. Red skin like the old Rose Centennial. Dark orange meat. Resists fusarium wilt, soil rot, susceptible to root knot Nematode. Great for northern states. **80-90 days. (Vine type)**
- HEAVY YIELDER**
5. Vardaman

Very delicious eating potato, has light orange skin and dark meat inside, no strings. Ideal for garden and small space. Vines good for small gardens. **About 90 days. (Bush type)**

6. Bunch Porto Rico

Light yellow to gold colored skin at harvest time. Cream to orange meat. Good eating, baking, and cooking potato. Plants have purple stems. Ideal for gardens with small space. **90-100 days. (Bush type)**

7. Nancy Hall

Grandpa's favorite. An old standby. Has cream flesh, cream/yellow inside. Delicious after being cured in storage. Sweet and tasty. White milk flows after slicing open. A real old-time favorite. Normal maturity around 110 days. Keeps very well. Ol' timey flavor. **(Vine type)**

8. White Triumphs White Yams

Tan skin and snow-white meat; smooth outside shaped nicely. Cooks very well. 90-120 days maturity. **(Vine type)**
- 9. Red Japanese**

Red/purple skin, ivory flesh. Bred for the Asian market. High dry matter but sweet. Resists fusarium wilt, susceptible to soil rot, root knot nematode, susceptible russet crack. Matures 110 days. **(Vine type)**
- HEAVY YIELDER**
10. Covington

Released by N.C. 2005. Rose color. Orange flesh. Blocky shape and fusiform. Resists fusarium wilt, soil rot, nematodes. Sweet taste. Produces many baking size. Matures 105 days. **(Vine type)**
- HEAVY YIELDER**
11. O'Henry

White-skinned, cream-fleshed variant of Beauregard. About 90-100 days. Resists white grub and soil rot. Susceptible to root-knot nematodes. **(Vine type)**
- HEAVY YIELDER**
12. Yellow Jewel

Developed at NCSU 1970 (moist and soft yellow flesh when baked). Roots are chunky to short, lite copperskin and orange flesh. Resists Fusar, wilt, southern knot nema, internal cork, sweet p. beetle. **100 days (Vine type)**
